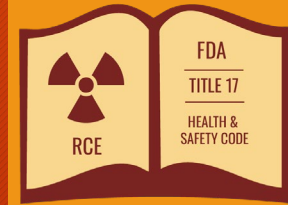


# Scope of Services



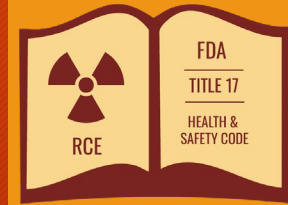
- RSO Remote Oversight for X-ray & Radiation-Producing Equipment (excluding Radioactive Materials)

# Mammography Inspection



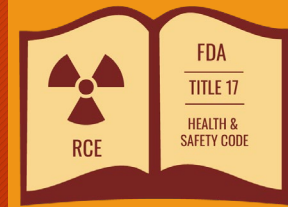
- Pre-Inspection Readiness: Audit and organize MQSA documentation (personnel qualifications, physicist reports, QC records)
- Inspection Day Coordination: Ensure units are ready, support staff responses, assist with documentation
- Physicist Survey Coordination: Track annual surveys, MEEs, and follow-up documentation
- Certification: Ensure facility certificates are current and properly displayed

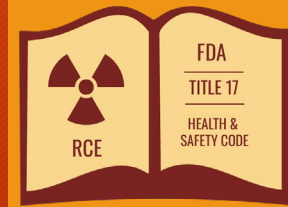

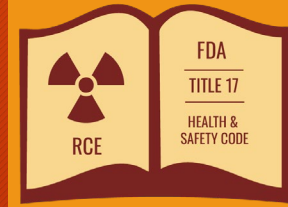

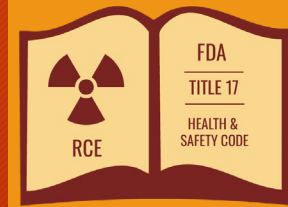

# Why choose me when you already have an RSO/Physicist group?



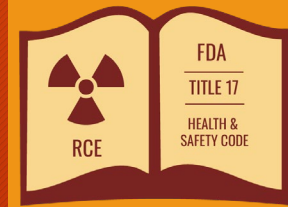
- Physicist groups provides excellent services, but their focus is on annual surveys and compliance at a very technical level.

# Agreement



- I understand the concern of a 1- year agreement. The challenge with “as-needed” compliance is that problems are usually only caught when they’ve already become costly — for example, failed inspections, citations, or delayed certifications.
